**Footnotes**

I'M BULLETPROOF chased the early leaders three wide, vied four wide into the stretch, responded when asked and closed well. ST PATRICKS APPEAL forced the early pace along the inside, placed a bid to gain the lead at the sixteenth pole but was outfinished in the final strides. TOO LOW FOR ZERO set the early pace on the outside, went three wide in the stretch and yielded in the final yards. EVANSVILLE VAN was unhurried early, saved ground and showed some effort late. BONK was outrun early, swung out five wide near the quarter pole and lacked a gain late. NEWTONS THEORY raced mid pack and lacked a late response. BERMUDA SUNSET was void of early speed, saved ground and was not a threat. HOPETOWN HERO was forwardly placed early four wide then retreated steadily.
