### Footnotes

SUAVEY broke outward at the break to get away well back, went five wide early, then began to gain some ground circling the field in the second turn and closed with a rush mid track to get up at the wire. COUNTRYBUMPKIN WHO set the early pace racing three wide, drew clear, held the advantage til nearing the wire and was turned away by fast closing foe. RADCLIFFE MAN prompted the early pace four wide, gained some ground in the stretch but didn't have enough late. YVETT'S MAAR was within striking distance early, made a move mid way then went evenly late. SOME FUN was outrun early, went three wide in the stretch and showed some effort late. DIXIE FILM was close in the early going saving ground then tired and faded. K O JUSTICE was unhurried early, went six wide in the stretch and lacked a rally. BRAX raced mid pack and failed to threaten. HEARING VOICES was never far back early racing four wide then gave way. CATABOLIZE dropped back and was not a factor.
