GO EMMIT GO pressed the pace, three wide then rallied at the quarter pole to draw off late. BOLIVAR SHAG was bumped at the break still making the lead but gave way late and managing to hold on for place. PUNCHLINE was on the inside, pressing the pace; made a bid and got up for show. UPTOWN EGO chased the pace, three wide and was in contention but hung late stretch. MINT MOHITO was bumped at the break and taken back going four wide; made an early bid down the backstretch but no late run. BERNARDO STAR had an inside trip in the middle of the pack but gave an even effort. ELEGANT ATTITUDE hopped badly at the start, saving ground early then was angled out in the stretch with a mild rally. RIVER JONES was squeezed at the start and steadied, went to the rail but had no rally. FINAL PROSPECTOR bore out in the first turn with no late run. CATALYTIC was three wide and outrun.
