MEMAS SWEET RUN broke sharp and pressed the pace from the inside, then made a bid and drew clear for the win. COLD N RUIDOSO was in contention, three wide, then angled in down the stretch and got up for place. PLAID LIGHTNING made the lead, then gave way at the three sixteenths pole and held on for show. ELWAY broke slow, then rallied between horses, angled out, going four wide but faltered late. K O JUSTICE was mid pack, five wide and no late run. CHANCY CLUE was near the front early and on the rail, then dropped back. STONEY STONESTREET broke slow, six wide with no rally. BENTLEY'SBROWNHOSS chased the pace, three wide and faded. BIG JUAN trailed the field early and passed a tired foe. SONGS GRAY HARE was near the back, three wide and retreated.
