JAC CADILLAC stalked the pace, saving ground with a late bid down the stretch. D E COWBOY KARMA broke slow and was taken back, two wide offering up a mild rally late. CALL ATTENDANT was in the middle of the pack, three wide with an even effort. LUCKY B LOU had an inside trip, angled out in the stretch and passed a tiring rival. SAILOR'S HALO pressed the pace, two wide and was through after the half. BLUFFING PEDRO was off slow, pulled up at the half mile pole and vanned off.
