Footnotes

HOPETOWN HERO made the lead, drawing off from the field to go wire to wire and be the easy winner. GHOSTLY FLY was mid field, angled out in the turn, and rallied to be second best. SORTA JOLLEY was near the back, four wide, then closed willingly to get up for show. PACHE'S PRIDE was in the middle of the pack, made a bid between horses, but flattened out down the lane. SPYGATE trailed the field, then offered a mild bid while drifting seven wide in the stretch. CHENAULT'S DREAM was in contention early, on the inside and dropped back steadily. CITY VOW forced the pace, two wide, but gave way at the eighth pole. SUREFIRE SUCCESS pressed the pace, from the inside and retreated at the quarter pole. FREDDY CAT was mid pack, four wide, then angled in on the turn and faded.
