CONSERVATIVE QUEEN stalked the pace, two wide, then offered a bid and got up for show. PALOMA MESA was near the back, angled out in the turn, going four wide and had a mild rally. SQUIGGLE forced the pace, three wide, made a bid on the turn but hung late. R LA PATRONA pressed the pace from the inside and retreated at the eighth pole. KITTY CASINO got off slow, three wide and trailed the field.
