Footnotes

DOMS FLASH showed early speed racing off the inside, drew clear into the turn then increased his advantage in the stretch. AGIBA YULLA prompted the early pace four wide, lacked a rally and followed the winner in the stretch. DESERT ROAD was within striking distance early, went between foes into the turn to place a bid and gained the show. DAMASCUS LAST HOPE was never far back early but lacked a rally in the stretch. BEAU WIZER was unhurried early, went four wide at the eight pole and lacked a late effort. HOLLYWOOD THUNDER was forwardly placed between foes then weakened. HEZA TRICK tracked the early leaders along the rail then gave way. STONE COLD ODDS raced wide and was not a threat. TWELVE CARROT GOLD showed little in a dull effort.
