MISSTA H W was in the middle of the pack, closed well, four wide for a driving finish. H BAR DOUBLE X X L chased the pace, four wide, rallied into the stretch but was outfinished at the wire. GONE ALREADY stumbled at the start and was mid field, four wide down the backside, made a bid down the lane to get up for show. RED TAPPER had no early foot, two wide, then angled out into the stretch with a mild rally. LORD IMAFASTCAT broke well but lugged out, five wide throughout with a mild rally. CALLME THE FIREMAN dueled for the lead, then dropped back. SAN PEDROS LOBO was pinballed at the break and steadied, moving to the inside with a mild bid. ANCIENT OF DAYS dueled for the lead and faded. DEVON'S PRINCE forced the pace, three wide then led briefly around the turn and retreated. PUNCH THE TICKET had a wide trip and trailed.
