Footnotes

HESABLUMIN prompted the early pace, went between foes at the quarter pole, sustained a bid to edge clear into the stretch and increased his advantage. MR. TRAV was within striking distance early, lost ground in the turn then came back in the stretch late to get up for the place. BONGO STRAITS broke slow at the start, began to close the gap along the rail then angled out five wide into the stretch and finished well late. OZILDA'S GLITTER showed early speed drawing quickly clear three wide, was challenged in the turn then weakened. STONEWALL RIOT was outrun early, went six wide near the sixteenth pole and showed some effort late. EL AMO was close early racing between rivals, sustained a brief bid at the eighth pole then gave way. STAFFHOUSE ROAD was wide throughout and passed tiring foes. LEESTOWNS FINALE was unhurried early, fanned seven wide near the eighth pole and lacked a bid. DUNN SLINGER was never far back early saving ground then retreated steadily after the first quarter.
