Footnotes

DUDE ON THE LOOSE had no early foot but was hustled up between horses, then angled out down the lane with a rally from strong, steady urging. EXPECT A GENIUS made the lead, daylighted early but wilted at the wire. SUPER SAPELLO had no speed on the inside, angled out at the eighth pole and closed the fastest. SNUFFY WHO stalked the pace, two wide but lacked the needed late response. ANCIENT APPEAL was mid field, four wide with a mild bid. UNBRIDLED EGO was in the middle of the pack on the inside with a mild late rally. CAROLYN ABBEY was in contention early offering an even effort. MISSION DELTA was near the back and had no late run. MOURAMOR was in the middle of the pack and dropped back. ZEE BEST HENNYSEE trailed throughout.
