JOYSSWEETJOY chased the pace, then rallied, four wide, with a strong late surge to get up for the win. HI HENNESSY was mid pack, going four to five wide throughout and closed willingly to grab second. HEZA TRICK dueled for the lead, two wide, made a bid, but was outfinished and held on for show. MIDNIGHT MAVRICK was near the back, on the rail, then rallied between horses, with a good try down the lane. THIS BUDS A TYGER pressed the pace, three wide, made a bid, but gave way late. TING dueled for the lead, on the inside and faded at the sixteenth pole. THREEGOODKIDS was mid field, angled out, going four wide, then offered a mild rally. SMOKIN AVENUE had no early foot, going three to four wide and passed a tired foe. FIRST VIEW RIDGE had no speed, on the inside and retreated.
