THENEW NORMAL made the lead, but blew the turn, going four wide, then got headed at the eighth pole and came back for the win. FRED'S HENNESSY pressed the pace, three wide, then rallied down the lane and got up for second. DOMS FLASH stalked the pace, three wide, then made a bid obtaining a brief lead at the eighth pole but was outfinished at the wire. REAL FLAXY was near the back, angled out and closed down the stretch, five wide. RASCAL WHO had no early speed, and made a bid up the rail. YOUR FLYING DUTCH trailed the early, on the inside and passed a tired foe. HENNESSYLADYLEGEND broke sharp, four wide and faded in the stretch.
