Footnotes

HIS SONG chased the early leader three wide, sustained a bid to duel into the stretch, gained a short lead at the sixteenth pole and held off a fast closing foe. BIG KISS was outrun early saving ground, angled out five wide, closed well finding his best stride late. MAXIMUM TWIST was allowed to settle early racing off the inside, angled in along the rail, showed some effort late and was up for the show. ATLANTIC THUNDER was within striking distance early, went four wide to place a brief bid then flattened. GONE JET drew quickly clear while saving ground, was challenged then dueled into the stretch and came up empty late. TEXAS SILVER was unhurried early, went three wide and lacked a late response. JUMP WEST was void of early speed, made a move mid way then faded. A GHOST BY CHOICE was forwardly placed early, retreated after a quarter and was distanced.
