OUR BIG SQUEEZE had no early foot going three wide, bore out in the stretch with a mild bid. HILLSIDE MANOR was four wide in mid pack but lacked a late response. BRITE RULER attended the pace briefly and dropped back at the three eighths pole. MAKE 'EM PAY was near the back and failed to fire. SUREFIRE SUCCESS trailed early and passed a tiring rival. PRINCE LOGAN was in the middle of the pack early and through at the three eighths pole.
