FOREST MOUSE pressed the pace, two wide, then gained command at the quarter pole and drew off for an easy win. TROUBLE RULES had no early foot, then rallied, four wide, to be second best. TRUSTEE TOM forced the pace, got in tight and was steadied at the half, then angled out, and offered a bid but hung late. STAR SURPRISE set the pressured pace, then dropped back around the turn, but offered a mild rally late. JACK CARTER stalked the pace, three wide, with an even effort. SOUTHERN HEAT WAVE trailed the field early and offered a mild bid, going five wide. SHIGEO was in contention early, four wide and gave way at the eighth pole. DANG was near the back, two wide and stopped.
