GALE SOURCE duel for lead on the outside rivals for quarter mile, responded to stake command at the half, went gamely under steady urging in drive to prevail. LIKE THE WIND chased leader from outset, went gamely when asked in drive but unable to reach winner and settled for second best. MARIES FAST LADY was allowed to settle during early running, came five wide into lane and finished with a belated bid. D. E. FANTAZMA racing in middle of pack from outset, lacked rally. DIABLA was never far back, swung five wide when making bid into stretch, flattened out in drive. QUEEN OF BRACKEN forwardly positioned for half, gave way in lane. WESTERN HAULER raced along rail, failed to menace. KRUZIN K O was not a factor. SOARING SPIRIT was outrun. BASIN ST. HEIRESS hustled to front along rail, dropped back after quarter mile.
