Footnotes

NO BLISS was mid field going five wide, closing with a rush on the outside. LIGHT UP ME stalked the pace, angled out stretch for the rally to get up for place. LAZER RUN made the lead, daylighting early only to give way at the sixteenth pole. ARE YOU CRAZY got off slow but made a steady gain going four wide. FIESTA FLING attended the pace, three wide and faltered at the eighth pole. MARTHA'S BID got pinched back and steadied at the half, angled to the inside, making a mild bid between horses. CHIMING LESLEY had a rail trip with a mild rally down the lane. CALL THE VET had no early speed going four wide and passed tiring rivals. TAP N TOOT was four wide with no late run. GOLD AND DIAMONDS was in contention early, steadied into the turn with no rally.
