CRAFTY SHEIK middle of pack, angled out stretch, driving finish. CHEROKEE ROLL set pace, gave way late. SOME KIND OF LUCK unhurried early, split foes, closed. ROMANINTHESTORM middle of pack, three wide, closed well late. ME CATCHUM chased pace, middle move, no late bid. JICK JACK JOKER no early foot, passed tiring rivals. SLEWCHERO pressed pace, tired. FIRST TOUCHDOWN chased pace, four wide, bid, hung. EL PROSPECTO chased pace, eased stretch.
