SOLD OUT SHOW well positioned from outset, commenced bid leaving far turn, responded to strong handling while racing between foes in drive and got up in time. CHANCEY UNC was never far back racing on the outside of rivals, came three wide into stretch, responded to gain nod mid stretch, went gamely but couldn't last. EROS EISHIN dueled along rail from outset, loomed danger mid stretch, weakened in final stages. LORD PRECOCITY allowed to settle in stride early, came four wide when making bid into stretch, finished a mile belated bid. WHOA SAILOR hustled to front along rail, set pace for half, gave way. MISSION S. D. forwardly positioned along inside for half, faded. MR MYSTERIOUS was never a threat. TURKOMAN PETE was always outrun.
