MARTINI TO GO within striking distance outside rivals from start, responded to handling entering stretch, took over mid stretch, drew off in late going. DONE WITH FLAIR dueled on the outside of foes from start, responded to gain nod at the half, went gamely when pressured in drive but couldn't last. SOARING DEA stalked leaders along inside form outset, moved up to loom danger into stretch, weakened in drive. FREE ZENE saved ground while forwardly positioned into stretch, had no rally. SHE'S WAY COOL was allowed to settle early, lacked response when asked. TRICK FALLS hustled to front, faded steadily after half. K O OKAY was always outrun.
