K O JUSTICE rated just off early leaders, commenced bid coming off rail three wide into stretch, responded to strong handling to gain command and drew clear in the end. DIXIE FILM dueled along rail into stretch, went gamely under pressure in drive but could not hold off winner and settled for second best. NEW MEXICO KID was allowed to settle for half, swung five wide into lane, finished with a belated mid track rally. STORMININTHEREIGN dueled for lead on the outside of rival from start, gained narrow edge at the half, went gamely into stretch, gave way in lane. HIGH RIDGE RUNNER forwardly positioned outside foes to stretch, had no rally. BOLD COTORO stalked leaders for half, faded steadily thereafter.
