CALLME THE FIREMAN pressed the pace early, then gained command at the quarter pole and drew off for the win. THREEGOODKIDS set the pace early, but gave way at the quarter pole and held on to place. OTILIO was mid pack, angled out, four wide and rallied down the stretch to get up for third. CALL IT A NIGHT was in contention, two wide, offered a mild bid around the turn, but flattened out down the lane. DRY GOLD was in the middle of the pack, on the inside with an even effort. KEY TO THE BAND was near the back, with a mild rally, four wide. BIG BRYCE trailed the field, three wide with a mild bid. SAN PEDROS LOBO had no early speed, on the inside and never fired. TANKA WINE stalked the early pace, three wide and retreated steadily. BORN BOND was forwardly placed, four wide, but faded in the turn.
