Footnotes

DIXIE FILM was mid pack, closing around horses, four wide for a driving finish. HARLAN'S TUNE pressed the pace, then made a bid, but was outfinished late and held on for second. JUBILAEM was mid field, on the rail, then got boxed in at the eighth pole and rallied late. TOO LOW FOR ZERO stalked the pace, got in tight and was steadied at the eighth pole, angled out and offered a bid. HOPETOWN HERO was in the middle of the pack, three to four wide with a mild late rally. DANDY DANCER set the pace, but faded at the eighth pole. HALLOWED FLAG had no early foot, three wide and lacked racing room down the lane. STAFFHOUSE ROAD was near the back, four wide and never fired. LITTLE LIZARD trailed the field on the rail and showed little.
