ONE BELL OF A BULL hustled to front along rail, no match for winner in drive but went gamely to hold second spot. EIGHTNCHANGEROOM was allowed to settle early, finished with a solid belated inside rally. CHACO LATTE within striking distance into stretch, had no rally. ELUSIVE JAZZ TIME saved ground to no avail. JOYSSWEETJOY hung wide from start, not a factor. YVETT'S MAAR failed to menace. LILS KING was never a threat. DUNN SLINGER vied while between foes to stretch, faded. COPELAN'S ACE was outrun.
