CHIEF LAZ was forwardly placed early, angled out, three wide around the turn and rallied down the lane to grab the win at the wire. HI HENNESSY pressed the pace, made a bid and gained command at the quarter pole but got outfinished at the wire and held on for second. MIDNIGHT MAVRICK set the pressured pace, but gave way at the quarter pole and held for show. STORMININTHEREIGN stalked the pace, three to four wide, made a bid, but hung late. SUAVEY was in the middle of the pack, five wide, with a mild late effort. JUST ALITTLE BEAD was mid pack, six wide, with a mild rally. ROCK RED was near the back, two to three wide and lacked a late response. KHAM ARTIST was mid field, three wide, with no late run. GROOMS BELLBOY trailed field, four to five wide and passed a tired rival. IRISH TITO was mid field, along the inside and retreated.
