JOHN'S KNIGHT OUT chased leader from outset, responded to take over after a half, kept to mild urging in drive and drew off in late going. VEGAS THIEF broke to front, set pace for half, went gamely when challenged in lane, no match late but clearly the second best. COVER CHARGER well back at a half, moved up along inside into stretch, finished with a solid belated rally to gain show spot. QUICK MEETING was not far back into stretch, had no rally. INVADER'S JUSTICE failed to menace. HOPE FOR PEACE was never a factor. WHY NOT TELL stalked pace for half, faded. QUARTA COROA (BRZ) was always outrun. TOO LOW FOR ZERO forwardly positioned on the outside from start6, broke down leaving quarter pole. LEESIDER well back early, moved up entering far turn, fell over fallen rival, unseated rider.
