SKAR made the lead, drawing clear to go wire to wire. ROSA'S CATENA stalked the pace going three wide, closed to get up for place. OUTOFECHO forced the pace on the inside with a mild bid. BROTHER JOHN D. trailed early, angled out mid stretch with a rally down the lane. TY'S PACHE was near the back, angled out at the eighth pole with a mild bid. OMER'S SURE SHOT pressed the pace going two wide, then faded at the eighth pole. SPELLING BEE JONES was mid field, attending the pace early on the inside, but was through at the quarter pole.
