AMAZING PACHE broke sharp and made the lead, drew clear of the field at the eighth pole for a driving finish. T V COMIC pressed the pace going two wide, made the lead briefly at the quarter pole and held on for place. ANCIENT APPEAL stalked the pace with a rail trip, angled out at the sixteenth pole to get up for show. CHARMING JIG got pushed in and bumped at the half mile pole, then rallied between horses. ZEE BEST HENNYSEE was mid pack going three wide with a mild rally. UNBRIDLED EGO chased the pace going four wide with an even effort. BIT OF LUX got off slow, angled out at the quarter pole going four wide with no late run. DANCING WITH BULLS had an inside trip and passed a tiring rival. SEE YA TOOTS was near the back with no late run. LESS ODDS pulled up at the quarter pole and was vanned off.
