Footnotes

LA SOBRINA gained command at the three eighths pole, drew off from the field and held on late with NATIVE LILLEE looming up on the outside. NATIVE LILLEE pressed the pace, along the inside, angled out in the stretch and rallied down the lane, just missing at the wire. STEP BY STEP was near the back, then closed between horses and got up for show. MOVING BOLDLY was mid field, on the inside with a mild rally. ICED was mid pack, made a bid on the turn and flattened out. WEST OF ROME trailed the field early along the rail, angled out on the turn and offered a mild bid, six wide. K O OKAY was near the back, three wide, but lacked a late response. RUN ABBY RUN had no early foot, five wide and never fired. K. O. CAPER was the early leader, but retreated at the quarter pole. BEAUTIFUL KIND was in contention, three wide and faded at the quarter pole.
