SOME KIND OF LUCK was mid field going three wide, closed fast on the outside for a driving finish. LOOK'N SPIFY ducked in at the gap, pressed the pace on the rail, then rallied down the lane to get up for second. MROBNOXIOUS pressed then pace going three wide, made a bid but hung in the lane. MUSIC MANIA was near the back going four wide, with a mild bid late. KEY TO THE BAND was mid pack going three wide, got in contention around the last turn but faded late. COMIC TALK made the lead and gave way at the quarter pole. WILSON had an inside trip and never fired. DANCING WITH BULLS was always outrun and was vanned off following the race.
