MR. SPEEDWHEEL MAN was mid pack, going four wide, then closed willingly and drew off from the field for the win. ACTIONABLE OFFENSE set the pace, but gave way at the eighth pole and held on for second. BEE'S BUCKAROO stalked the pace, three wide, with a mild bid to take third. VAMANOS AMIGO was mid field, four wide, with a mild rally. TIZ SEXY pressed the pace, two wide, but flattened out down the lane. WHOZ THAT CAT had no early foot, three wide, with mild late interest. WESTERN SHERIFF trailed the field early, angled out, going four wide and improved his position. TAX ME was near the back, three wide, but lacked a late response. CHIEF GET A CLUE was in the middle of the pack, along the inside, offered a mild bid around the turn, then dropped back. OVER THE RIVER was in contention early, four wide, but through after the half.
