BOLD MEETING had no early foot, then closed between horses on the turn, angled out four wide down the stretch to just get up for the win. OCEAN LAD was forwardly placed, going two wide, rallied down the lane but got edged at the wire. COASTAL FLASH pressed the pace, three wide, offered a mild rally but was outfinished late and got up for third. CROWN LOYAL set the pace, but faltered at the sixteenth pole. ANGEL THE BULL was near the front early, then dropped back down the backstretch and offered a mild rally late. COW PUNCHIN CASEY was in contention early along the rail, but gave way at the quarter pole. AMPHITRITES GIFT was near the back, made a bid on the turn, three wide and flattened out. MR. HOLMES trailed the field, two wide and showed little.
