INITIAL T was mid field, along the inside, angled out, three wide in the stretch, closing willingly to just get up for the win. SAGITTARIAN made the lead and got edged at the wire to hold on to second. TIZAHIGHBRITE had no early foot, angled out in the stretch and rallied between horses to deadheat for third. LANI'S EXCESS was allowed to settle, angled out in the stretch and closed, three wide, deadheating for show. APACHE GIRL stalked the pace, three wide, offered a bid, but lugged in down the stretch. CHILLUM pressed the pace, on the inside and was steadied at the sixteenth pole. SHOULD was mid pack, angled out down the backstretch, three wide and had no late run. PAT'S PROSPECT was in contention early, four wide and faded at the quarter pole.
