SID'S WONDER was well back early, rallied three wide at the half-mile pole, split rivals at the quarter pole and was clear late under a mild drive. WILDINTHEWILDWEST was unrushed early, rallied three wide at the quarter pole, then couldn't get to the winner. SELF APPOINTED stalked the pace, bid at the half-mile pole, then couldn't match strides. NOBEL TWO STEP stalked the pace five, bid at the half-mile pole, then faltered. COWBOY WHISKERS stalked the pace inside, bid at the half-mile pole, then gave way in the drive. CONN E SOCKS and. EVER TOLD were not factors. GONE TO DANCE was clear early, then couldn't last.
