BUFFALO GAP chased pace from outset, responded to gain narrow edge at the half, responded to steady handling in lane, drew off in late going. WILD CAT OFFENSE chased pace throughout, went gamely in drive but was unable to match strides with winner late, although much best of others. GENERAL PALMER hustled to front, set pace for quarter mile, gave way. THUNDER ROCKET well back at the half, improved position. GLOBAL APPEAL was never a threat. CRYPTO RULER was outrun. TIZ WORTH BELIEVIN was never close.
