FLOMOT stalked the pace, three wide, then closed down the lane for a driving finish. DIXIE FILM was in contention early, three wide, offered a bid and held on for second. BAD AS BEAN set the pace, two wide, but weakened late and held on for show. CLARA'S TIZZYCAT was allowed to settle, two wide, then closed fast but too late. SOME KIND OF LUCK was near the back, on the inside, angled out in the stretch, going four wide and offered a mild rally. YOUR GENERAL pressed the pace along the rail, got in tight and was steadied in the turn and faded. CATTLEMAN PROSPECT trailed the field, four wide and passed a tired foe. NEW MEXICO KID was forwardly placed, four wide and retreated at the quarter pole.
