Footnotes

WIND ON WATER made the lead and was under pressure from F D ICY, he dug in down the stretch for a driving finish. F D ICY was forwardly placed early, three wide, offered a bid, but it was not enough to get by the winner. WARREN'S MR. LUCKY bobbled at the start, but managed to be mid pack, then closed, four to five wide to get up for third. A P APTITUDE had no early speed, and offered a mild rally between horses. SIMPLE DEAL pressed the pace, two wide and faded at the quarter pole. IRISH MONARCH got off slow, on the inside and showed mild interest too late. FIRST VIEW RIDGE stalked the pace, two wide and retreated at the quarter pole. SMOKIN AVENUE was mid field, two wide and dropped back at the three sixteenths pole. TEXAS BAD BOY had no early foot, on the inside and never fired.
