TANGO MANGO within striking distance from start, responded to take over into stretch, went unchallenged, ridden out to wire. DUNN SLINGER dueled along rail from outset, no match for winner in drive but went gamely to hold unto second spot. STONEWALL RIOT was never far back, came three wide into lane, finished with a mild rally. LILS KING was allowed to settle early, swung five wide into stretch, flattened out in drive. PIRATE'S JOURNEY came from off pace into stretch along rail, failed to menace. QUICK MEETING came off rail five wide from off pace into stretch, failed to threaten in drive. HOPETOWN HERO was outrun. WARREN'S GUS dueled along rail for quarter mile, faded. AGGRAVATED BATTERY vied for early lead, dropped back after quarter mile.
