EIGHTNCHANGEEROOM rated off just off early pace, commenced bid circling rivals leaving far turn, came five wide into stretch, gained command mid stretch and drew off in late going. TONY THE CAT dueled on the outside of rivals from start, came four wide into stretch, went gamely but was no match for winner late and settled for second best. ONE BELL OF A BULL forwardly positioned while racing between foes along inside, came off rail into stretch and finished with a belated mid track rally. ELUSIVE JAZZ TIME well back while racing four wide into stretch, finished with a mild rally. RADCLIFFE MAN dueled while racing between foes into stretch, gave way. YVETT'S MAAR failed to menace. STARRING CHAYO was not a factor. PACHE OF GOLD hustled to narrow early lead while between rivals to stretch, faded. CHACO LATTE forwardly positioned while saving ground for quarter mile, dropped back.
