THREE FORKS stalked the pace, then rallied up the rail for a driving finish. PATRONESS KATHY made the lead but got edged late and held on for second. TATE B had no early speed, angled out around the turn, then closed fast going five wide to get up for third. GOLDEN LIONESS broke sharp, pressing the pace, three wide, but gave way in the stretch drive. IS THIS SEAT TAKEN was mid pack, then angled out, four wide and offered a mild bid. FIESTY PATSY was in the middle of the pack along the inside, with a mild late rally. SUNDAY BONNET was near the back, on the rail and lacked a late response. E. B. ACLASSICDON had no early foot, then got steadied early and had no late run. BRIDESGONEWILD broke slow, on the inside and had no rally. HENNESSY'S LOVE was in contention early, two wide and retreated in the turn.
