GREEN TEA was allowed to settle early, commenced bid circling field leaving far turn, came four wide into stretch, responded to handling throughout drive and just missed in gutsy effort. JUSTA MILLION was never far back, came three wide into stretch, finished with a mild stretch bid. MONITORING hustled to front, set pace for three quarters, tired in drive. IMA WILD FLOWER saved ground to no avail. DANCING RANCHERA moved up from just off pace to contest issue at the half, gave way in lane. ME MIKA chased pace along inside into stretch, faded. GYPSIANNA was never a threat. BRIDESGONEWILD always outrun.
