FOREST MOUSE rated ;just off early pace while outside of rivals, commenced bid three wide into stretch, responded to strong handling to gain nod mid stretch, kept to task and proved best in the end. IMCO SPIRIT (IRE) was never far back while outside rivals, came four wide when making bid into lane, responded to handling,in drive, finished well but too late. PLEA AGREEMENT was allowed to settle in stride early while racing along inside, came three wide when making bid into stretch, dropped to rail mid stretch and finished with good energy. GLOBAL STAGE came from middle of pack four wide into stretch, had no rally for drive. HURRICANE LAKE hustled to front, dueled, into stretch, tired in late going. INFINITE RESOURCE well back into stretch, lacked response when asked. MCKENNA'S JUSTICE raced in middle of pack along rail, was not a factor. FOG ALERT was never a threat. QUIET AGAIN stalked pace from start, responded to gain narrow edge after half mile, faded steadily in lane. JACK CARTER chased pace for half, dropped back suddenly after half.
