ZAGORA'S PRIDE set the pace, then drew off down the lane to go wire to wire. AMOROSO pressed the pace, three wide, offered a bid, but was second best. GROOMS BELLBOY was near the back, angled out, going four wide, offered a mild rally and got up for show. RIVER JONES chased the pace, three wide, but lacked racing room at the eighth pole, finally got loose and had a mild rally. ROMANINTHESTORM was mid field, on the inside, angled out at the eighth pole, going three wide, with a mild bid. MISSTA H W trailed the field, angled out, four wide and showed mild late interest. WILDINTHEWILDWEST was in contention early along the rail, but dropped back in the stretch. YOUR MY IRISH PAL forced the pace, three wide and faded in the turn.
