Footnotes

NAUGHTY MOVES was unhurried early, making a steady gain up the rail for a driving finish late stretch. LYNDEE K was mid field, three wide then rallied down the lane to get up for place. SUPER SCANDAL was near the back, angled out at the quarter pole going five to six wide and closed willingly late. MISS APACHE made the lead but gave way at the eighth pole. HALF IRISH CREAM had no early foot on the inside with a mild bid between horses. SNAP MY PICTURE attended the pace, two wide, then got steadied at the eighth pole and dropped back. ARE YOU CRAZY was in the middle of the pack on the inside, angled out at the eighth pole with no response. GOLD MEDAL HUNTER pressed the pace, two wide but gave way midstretch. TAP N TOOT was mid pack, four wide, then got checked at the eighth pole and had no rally. NITES WILD GAZE stalked the pace, three wide and faded at the quarter pole.
