Footnotes

AWESOME LAUNCH stalked the pace, three wide, rallied at the quarter pole and drew off from the field. RUHLUM was near the back, made a bid at the three eighths pole and closed willingly three wide down the lane. SIZZLING FARGO chased the pace, four wide and had a mild rally late. SUMMER SOLSTICE pressed the pace, two wide, made a bid on the turn but weakened in the stretch drive. SORTA JOLLEY had a rail trip early and no early foot, angled out in the stretch with a mild bid late. GOLDEN WAGER was mid field on the inside with a mild rally. GOLDEN CAPOTE trailed early and passed tiring rivals. TORCH DOWN set the pace on the inside but came up empty in the lane. WESTERN ACT was mid pack, three wide and retreated at the quarter pole. CHROME BOY was in contention early, three wide and dropped back at the quarter pole.
