MISSYA JACK made the lead, drew off early and was ridden out for the win. DAWN TERA forced the pace, three wide, offered a bid, but was second best. OUR TESTAROSSA was in the middle of the pack, angled out, six wide around the turn and showed mild late interest. OLE' N SOLO had no early foot, but made a mild bid up the rail. CREATE OLE stalked the pace, four wide and gave way in the stretch. LADY FRENCH was mid field, three wide, but lacked a late response. IAMALOUISIANAGIRL was mid pack along the rail, dropped back around the turn and passed tired ones. LAST GOOD REASON was in contention early, three wide, but faded at the quarter pole. BRIDESGONEWILD had no speed, on the inside, with no late run. RUSSIAN ON THE RUN pressed the pace, on the inside and retreated at the five sixteenths pole.
