Footnotes

DESERT JACK was mid pack, made a bid, three wide, grabbing the lead in late stretch, then got headed, but came back on for a driving finish. BROTHER JOHN D. had no early foot, then closed, going four wide, but hung late getting edged at the wire. COSMIC CHI hopped at the start and was unhurried early, then angled out down the backstretch and made a steady gain to get up for show. FORT STANTON LAD stalked the pace, gained command around the turn, but gave way in the stretch. BOLD COTORO forced the pace, two to three wide, offered a bid in the turn and faded in the stretch. K O JUSTICE was near the back, four wide and lacked a late response. MILLER WHO pressed the pace, two wide, dueled down the backstretch and retreated at the quarter pole. AMOROSO set the pace, dueled down the backstretch but faded at the quarter pole. SANTO BUENO was mid pack, four wide and stopped at the quarter pole.
