DEL MAR DRAMA chased the pace, three wide, then rallied down the lane to get up late. COASTAL FLASH set the pace, drifted, three wide in the lane and gave way at the sixteenth pole. STORMING SEA was near the back, then closed, four wide to get up for show. REAL COOL JAZZ trailed the field early, then circled horses, six wide, closing too late. JUST LIKE WILLIAM was mid pack, three wide, with mild interest. MAGNIFICENT STORM stalked the pace along the rail, angled out around the turn and faded at the three eighths pole. ROAR OF EAGLES was mid field, on the rail, with no late run. HIGH RIDGE RUNNER was forwardly placed, three wide and retreated in the stretch. ANYBODYS GUESS had no early foot, five wide and never fired. SANDYNECK pressed the pace, from the inside, and stopped at the quarter pole.
