KELLY SON was in contention early, then rallied between horses and drew off down the stretch. ELUSIVE JAZZ TIME made the lead, two wide, but faltered at the sixteenth pole. STORMING SPIRIT was mid pack, on the rail, made a bid and got up for show. DOMS TRICK pressed the pace along the inside, but dropped back in the stretch. FIRST JOURNEY got pushed wide into the first turn and lacked a late response. INDIES SPRING stalked the pace, three wide, but faded in the stretch. RAYADO GOLD was carried wide into the first turn, going two to three wide, with no late run. CALL ME SHREWD had no speed, on the inside and no rally. PULPITS PROSPECT had no early foot, two wide and retreated. RUNNING HOLLYWOOD blew the first turn, going four wide and stopped.
